NEW BUSINESS

LOGGING – IRON VALLEY GOLF COURSE

There was a report that logging is going on in Iron Valley. Jeff Steckbeck is going to check with ownership to see if this is going on.

SUMP PUMP DISCHARGE – MINERSVILLE

Steve Danz received emails concerning sump pump water at 346 Boyd St. Older Borough Ordinances prohibited pumping water onto the borough roadways and into drainage ditches or road inlets. The newer Stormwater Management Ordinance 2012-3 specifically allows pumping of “clean” crawl space and basement water into the Borough’s MS4 system. The Planning Commission believes the newer ordinance applies and rectifies what had previously been an untenable and unrealistic prohibition.

GLRA – STIPEND

Marie Tribioli made the motion, seconded by Steve Tribioli to approve stipends for appointed representative from the Borough, Gerald Boughter. Motion passed.

LORI MATTIS – REAPPOINTMENT TO BOARD OF HEALTH (5 YEAR TERM)

ORDINANCE 2018-1 – AMENDMENT TO CODE OF ORDINANCES – BURNING

Al Brandt made the motion, seconded by John Karinch to amend the Code of Ordinances to allow burning in Residential Forest Areas.
